 - ii. The pattern of assistance of rules governing such grants-in-aid have received the approval of the Ministry of Finance, as required under Government of India decision No. (1) under DFPR-Rules 20.
- Terms and conditions of the service of the employees employed under the **Project Tiger and Elephant Scheme** are not higher than those applicable to similar categories of employees of Central Government and where it is not in accordance with above, the relaxation of Ministry of Finance have been obtained for such discrepancies as required under GFR 230(12)(I).

- Tiger/Elephant Reserves will spend Grants-in-aid exclusively in pursuance of the X. objectives envisaged in rules/memorandum of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Project Tiger & Elephant' and for the purpose it is being sanctioned.
