The undersigned is directed to forward a copy of DoE's D.O. No. 1(13)/PFMS/2022 dated 18th May, 2022 (copy enclosed) on the above mentioned subject for information and compliance.

- DoE has attached the report showing unspent balances with SNAs of Schemes as on 31st March, 2022 and 30th April, 2022 (copy enclosed). DoE has further instructed to take into account the unspent amounts of the preceding financial year available with SNA while releasing funds in
- DoE has further instructed that instalment of not more than 25% of the annual scheme outlay 3. is to be released to the State Government only after 75% of the funds released earlier- including both the Central and State Share are utilized.
- Hence, all the Programme Divisions are requested to review the unutilized funds in the SNA accounts, Central Share released but not transferred to SNA account, and the outstanding State Share before release of next instalment of funds. The schemes for which the Cabinet has approved release of more than 25% in one instalment, any instalment of more than 25% should be released only with concurrence of DoE.



Dear Secretary,

As you are aware, the Department of Expenditure (DoE), vide OM dated 23rd March, 2021, has prescribed a new procedure (the SNA model) for flow of funds under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS). The SNA model has improved visibility of unspent amount available with the States and the Single Nodal Agencies notified for implementation of CSS in each State.

- As per the information available in PFMS, an amount of Rs.1.27 Lakh Crore was available in 2. the Single Nodal Accounts of SNAs on 31st March, 2022. Similarly, as on 30th April 2022, an amount of approx. Rs.1.188 Lakh Crore was available in the SNA accounts. A report showing the unspent balances available with SNAs of Schemes of your Department as on 31st March, 2022 and 30th April, 2022 is attached. Moreover, a significant amount of Central share released in the fag end of the financial year could be held up in the State Treasury awaiting transfer into the SNA account. Thus, a significant amount of funds are available with SNAs in various States for Scheme implementation. Release of funds when previous funds remain unutilized is contrary to principles of financial control. Therefore, it is of utmost importance that such unspent amounts of the preceding financial year available with SNAs are taken into account while releasing funds in 2022-23.
- As per DoE guidelines, installment of not more than 25% of the annual scheme outlay is to be released to the State Government only after 75% of the funds released earlier - including both Central and State share - are utilized. Therefore, before release of next installment of funds, you are requested to review the unutilized funds in the SNA accounts, Central share released but not transferred to SNA account, and the outstanding State share. For Schemes for which the Cabinet has approved release of more than 25% in one installment, any installment of more than 25% should be released only with concurrence of DoE.
