## Call for Application -Senior Research Fellow

The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) is a statutory body under the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MoEFCC) established in the year 2005 (website https://ntca.gov.in/). The main objective of this Authority is to strengthen tiger conservation in the country under the provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. The role of the NTCA is to provide central consultation to States and tiger reserves through advisories/normative guidelines, based on appraisal of tiger status, ongoing conservation initiatives, within the ambit of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and guidelines of Project Tiger / National Tiger Conservation Authority. This includes protection, habitat amelioration, day to day monitoring, eco-development for local people in buffer areas, voluntary relocation of people from core/critical tiger habitats, and addressing human-wildlife conflicts. Additionally, NTCA also leads the country wide assessment of the status of tiger, co-predators, prey and habitat once in four years.

To further support the expansion of works at NTCA, applications are now invited for the engagement of two Senior Research Fellow (SRF) positions (through empaneled outsourced agency).
