Sub: Inviting nominations of Indian Forest Service officers for appointment to the post of Deputy Inspector General, NTCA, New Delhi, in the scale PB-4 (37,400-67,000/-), Grade Pay - Rs. 8,900/- on tenure deputation basis under Non- Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change – reg.

Sir/ Madam,

The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA), a statutory body under the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, invites application from eligible officers for the post of Deputy Inspector General in the NTCA Headquarter, New Delhi on deputation basis. The details of post and eligibility criteria are given below:

Note 1. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or other organization/ department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. Note 2. The maximum age limit for appointment shall be, not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

2. The officers should have completed the requisite 'cooling off' period in their parent cadre before they are recommended for a second central deputation.

3. If an officer does not join within the prescribed time, his appointment would be treated as cancelled and the officer concerned would stand debarred from Central deputation for a period of five years from the date of issuing orders of his/ her appointment. Further, the officer would be debarred from being considered for any foreign training as also from being given cadre clearance for being deputed on foreign assignments / consultancies abroad during period of debarment.

4. The officers debarred for central deputation should not be sponsored for consideration for the post of DIGF till they complete their debarment period / become eligible for consideration.

5. It is requested that the duly filled application(s) of willing, eligible officer(s) and whose services can be spared along with vigilance clearance, attested copies of APARs of last five year and concurrence of the State Government may please be forwarded to Deputy Inspector General, National Tiger Conservation Authority, B-1 Wing, 7th Floor, Pt.
